Fine Art Giclée Archival Prints

Fine Art Prints are also known as Giclée Prints. Fine Art Prints are printed with high-quality archival pigment-based inks using a 12-color process to output ultra-high resolution images. Our art papers come from the German state of Saxony where it has passed the museum collection level IS09706 testing standard and received the prestigious International Forest Stewardship Council FSC certification. Papers are alpha-cellulose acid-free, lignin-free and have a neutral pH.

Giclée prints are a variation of inkjet prints. As with inkjets in Digital Presses, the inkjets in Giclée printers spray paint through small nozzles directly onto the paper's surface. The name Giclée derives from "gicler", which in French means "to spray".

There are fundamental differences between the inkjets that are used in Digital printing and inkjets used in Giclée printing.

Ultimately Giclée printing can be thought of as very highend inkjet printing, which has comparable print qualities to a Silver Halide print.







The paper uses an optical brightening agent to create a cooler tonality that results in a whiter white point. It is made from wood pulp and therefore considered archival grade.
